

Protocol Guidelines for AKA Pledge



All sorors should be able to recite the Pledge by memory.



When reciting the Pledge, there is no "s" on the word strength.



The Pledge should be recited at the beginning or end of chapter meetings.



When reciting the Pledge after the Hymn, keep arms crossed (right over left) and hands clasped, conclude with a gentle, inconspcuious hand squeeze.



The Pledge should never be printed on any item.



The Pledge should not be recited publicly.

The official sorority song is Alpha Kappa Alpha National Hymn.




The Hymn should be sung at a brisk pace.
